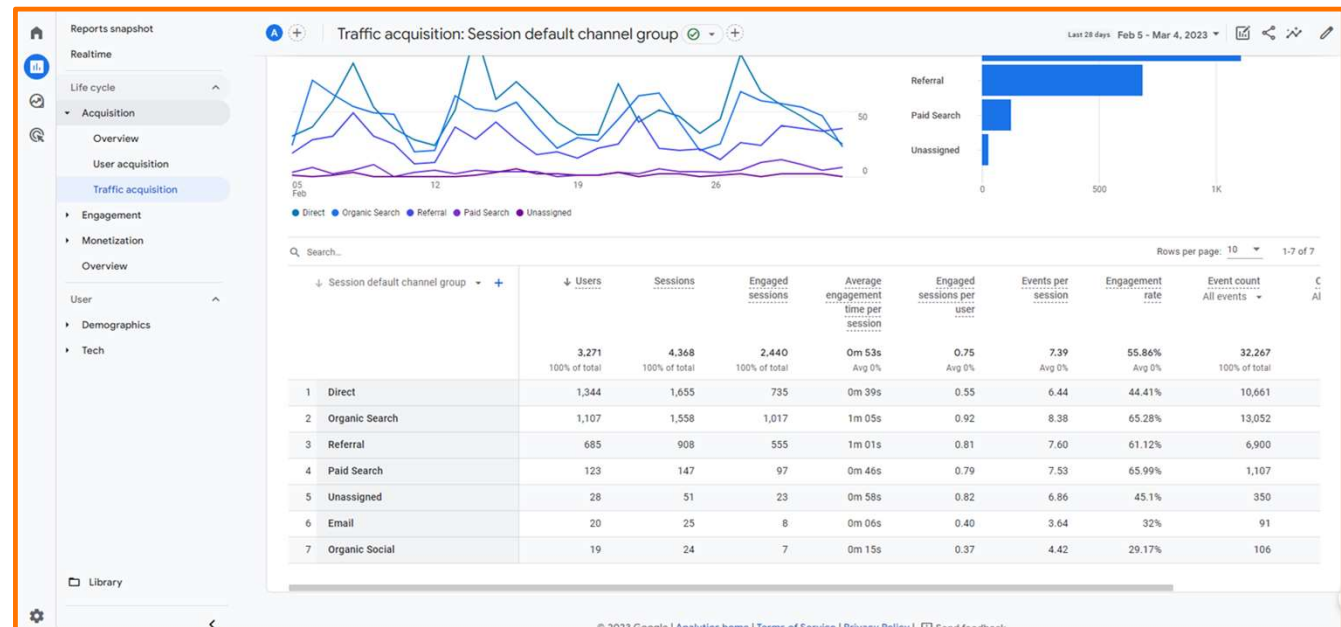

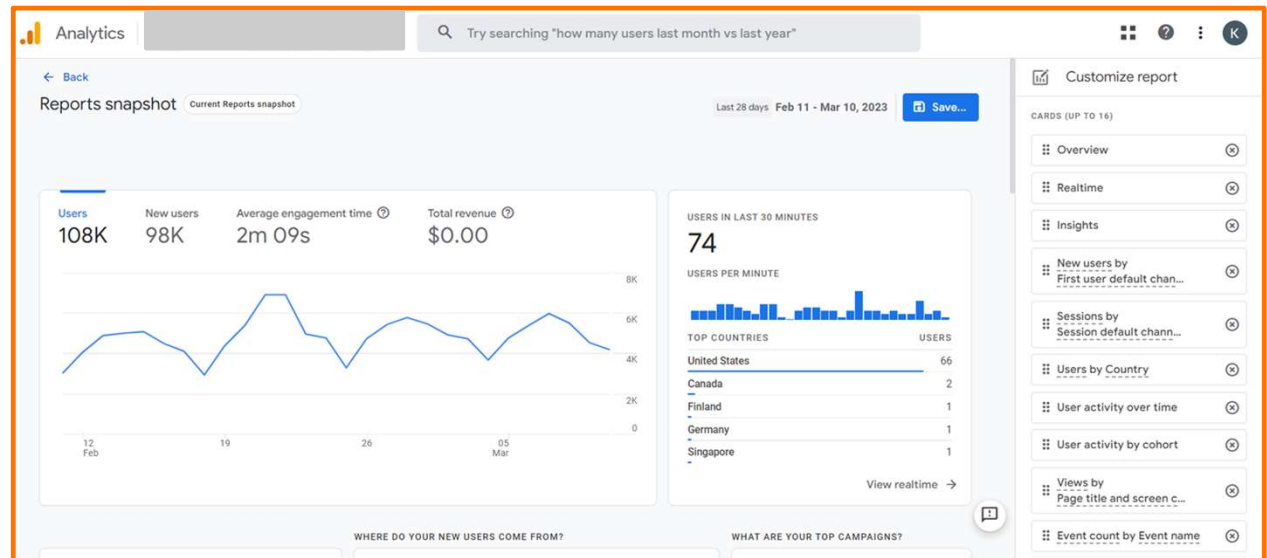
Customising a report

- Metrics
- Filters
- Charts
- Summary Cards
